



Charge:

Sponsored by the Provost and Vice President of Administration & Finance, the Capital Planning Committee (CPC) advises senior leadership on the establishment of goals and priorities for academic and administrative program capital investment needs, and reviews and comments on planning programs, the siting of new facilities, and the scope and priority of major capital projects for buildings and infrastructure. CPC reviews and comments upon the campus masters plan, precincts plans, financing strategies for capital projects, and the designs of campus buildings.

The CPC is co-chaired by the sponsors' designated leadership staff, Senior Associate Vice President of PP&D and the Dean of the College of Science & Engineering, and staffed by PP&D Planning & Design and Capital Project Management leadership staff. Based on monthly meetings, the co-chairs make recommendations and advise the Sponsors and the President on all matters relating to long range planning, major capital project development and the physical planning.
