President's Message



University Advancement November 16, 2023

About Us

- University Advancement exists to secure philanthropic support for SF State; create awareness and generate support for its academic and research programs; and build a culture of philanthropy at SF State.
- We support the entire University faculty, staff, students and alumni, in particular.
- We have a staff of about 61.
- Base Budget FY 23-24 = \$6.4 million or 2% of SF State Budget.

University Advancement Units

- Advancement Services processes gifts and manages University's donor database (CRM).
- Alumni Relations & University Engagement engages alumni and plans signature events.
- Strategic Marketing & Communications promotes the university.
- University Development raises money for the University.
- Vice President's Office provides division-wide oversight and operations.

UA Related Unit – SF State Foundation

- An independent 501c3 philanthropic foundation that exists solely to manage endowed gifts on behalf of SF State.
- The Foundation's operations are managed by University Advancement staff.
- The Foundation provides an annual subsidy to University Advancement.
- The Foundation's board increased its subsidy for FY 2023 2024 from \$515K to over \$830K.

Resources Management since 2020

- 1. We work with SF State Foundation to increase subsidy to decrease dependence on general funds.
- 2. We imposed a hiring freeze and layoff for a total decrease of 11 positions (from 72 to 61) across Advancement (more efficient in our operations).
- 3. Created operational efficiencies in SMC with centralization of some college-based marketing and communications positions.
- 4. We deferred our single biggest non-personnel expense (CRM). Now completing migration.
- 5. Used carryforward to cover some critical one-time costs to supplement University investment in market research.







Members of the UBC, with a shared commitment to transparency in fiscal decision-making, serve to advise the University and community about budget matters, and bring concerns of the students, faculty and staff to the administration."

Please note:

- UBC does not create or manage the university budget; it supports transparency by helping to expand budget literacy, share resources and listen to the campus community.
- UBC receives feedback from the campus community in various ways, including through its members who are your peers: staff, faculty, students, administrators. Each has a seat on the UBC Steering Committee, which will direct feedback to the appropriate resource and/or, consider the topic for a future presentation at UBC.
